CAPSTONE ACADEMY SUPER HERO!

River Browning attended Capstone Academy's ESE Pre-K for one school year. He was a transfer student under the Developmentally Delayed program.

His mother called the school to discuss securing a space for River to attend Capstone Academy during the 2018/2019 school year. She felt his current setting did not recognize his full potential.

River received "curb to curb" bus service as both his parents worked. His dad is active duty military.

He was very verbal but often spoke about topics that he preferred, such as hippos. Social stories and talk helped guide River to understanding why his peers acted a certain way or to remind him of an appropriate way to respond as he would often call out when a peer was not doing something the way he would do it.

River transitioned into the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten setting mid-year and blossomed. He was in a bigger group setting with more verbal peers (ones that could talk back) and flourished.

His VPK assessment at the end of the school year showed that he was exceeding expectations in print knowledge and phonological awareness; and on track in oral language/vocabulary and mathematics.

Formal re-evaluation for program dismissal occurred in May, and he no longer needs ESE services. He will go into General Education Kindergarten with no Individual Education Plan in the fall.

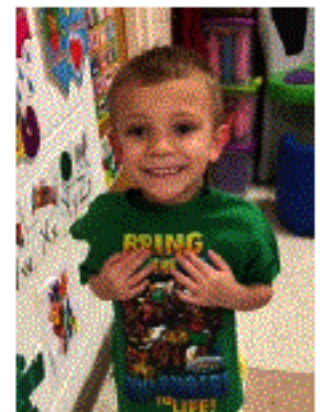
